Excursion: **Half Day City Tour**
Date: 2nd November

A fascinating 4-hour tour of the elegant turn-of-the-century districts that earned Buenos Aires the soubriquet of the Paris of South America. From the charming cobbled alleys and colonial architecture of San Telmo to the colorful Boca district, along to the Plaza de Mayo, dominated by the Casa Rosada (Government House), the Nación Bank, the Cathedral and original Parliament House, up the leafy Avenida de Mayo towards the imposing grandeur of the Palace of Congress and then on to finish at the historically fascinating Recoleta Cemetery, you will discover the facts, stories and anecdotes that make up the colourful tapestry of the history of Buenos Aires.

Excursion: **Dinner & Show Carlos Gardel**
Date: 2nd November

At the end of the XIXth. Century when the town of Buenos Aires was trying to become a city and the tango started to spread amongst the locals and immigrants, one of the most picturesque quarters was "El Abasto". A working city during the day where the tango prevailed during the night. The Abasto neighbourhood, the main supply market to the city (hence its name, in Spanish, "abastecer" means to supply) witnessed the rise of a popular idol "Carlos Gardel". He grew up in this area and later became the personification of the tango itself. Today, more than 100 years later, "Esquina Carlos Gardel" opens its doors in the original site of "Chanta Cuatro", the restaurant and hotel where Carlos Gardel gathered with his friends to dine and sing. This tango club and restaurant, decorated in an Art Nouveau style, recreating the sophistication and luxury of the salons of old times, features high-tech acoustics and superb dancers, creating a wonderful tango environment with first class artistic performances, together with good cuisine.

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5 November	Buenos Aires - Iguazu	09:05 - 10:55
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Destination: Iguazu Falls

Excursion: **Full Day Argentine Falls - Shared**
Date: 6th November

There are few waterfalls as majestic as Iguazú – or Iguacu, the Portuguese spelling – Falls along the border of Argentina. The falls are actually anywhere from 160 to 275 separate cascades (depending on the water level) with heights of roughly 263 feet (80 meters).

Sometimes also spelled Iguassu, the name of the falls comes from a Guarani Indian word meaning “great water.” An average of approximately 53,000 cubic feet (1,500 cubic meters) of water flows over Iguazu Falls each second. The subtropical rainforest surrounding the falls contains more than 2,000 species of vascular plants and is home to an abundance of wildlife, including toucans, parrots, and more than 400 other species of birds; tapirs; jaguars; ocelots; giant anteaters; howler monkeys; coatis; a variety of lizards, and countless butterflies. The park has been included on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

The tour begins visiting the Argentine side of the falls. Stroll along the lower Circuit just over a kilometre (half a mile) of paths running along the basin of the Devil’s Gorge that take you by turns under small splashing waterfalls or hopping over rivulets into the heart of the cascades with walkways that are only a few metres from the edge of the main falls, to be enveloped in the clouds of fine spray rising up from the raging torrent. Continue on the small ecological train which chugs cheerfully through the rainforest, under the thick foliage inhabited by languid butterflies and lizards, while the sounds of birds and monkeys fill the air. At Estación Garganta there is another pathway rising above the other end of the Devil’s Gorge which leads to a panoramic point with stunning views of the broad upper lip of the falls. The 90-metre Garganta del Diablo (Devil’s Gorge) and the sight of vast curtains of white froth that seem to hang suspended in mid-air before plunging far down into distant spray instil you with a strong sense of vertigo, a terrifying attraction that draws you ever closer to the fragile rails of the balcony overhanging the main falls.

Excursion: **Gran Aventura – Shared without transfers**
Date: 6th November

An exciting adventure combining jungle and waterfall sightseeing. The tour begins with a 4WD open truck drive across the rainforest, along the Yacaratiá Trail sighting flora and wildlife. After an 8 km (5 mile) truck ride, a short climb of stairs leads to the platform where we embark on a thrilling boat ride upstream along the Canyon of the Iguassu River to approach Devil’s Throat Canyon, San Martín Island and the main falls: Three Muskateers, San Martín and Bosetti.

We arrive to the lower circuit and disembark. The catwalks shall take us back to the Hotel through tropical vegetation, exotic butterflies and birds, and imposing close-up views of the falls.

Duration: 2,5 hours

Refreshments: Drinks, such as soft drinks, coffee or beer may be included to be served on the Catwalks – on request.

Level of effort: The tour comprises 100 meters of stairs to climb. The ride is restricted to pregnant women and people with physical / medical problems.

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Clothing recommendation: All guests must be advised to bring rubber soled shoes as the catwalks and boats are always damp and can get slippery. We strongly recommend wearing a lightweight water-proof jacket to help keeping as dry as possible when the boat approaches the falls. Before embarkation, passengers receive life-vests and plastic containers in which to protect photographic and filming equipment. Be ready to be splashed and get WET!

Excursion: Half Day Brazilian Falls – Shared
Date: 7th November

The falls and the surrounding forest are protected in national parks on both sides of the border: Parque Nacional Iguazu in Argentina and Parque Nacional do Iguaçu in Brazil. Both parks have been included on the UNESCO World Heritage List. The Brazilian side of the falls offers a more panoramic view than the close up on the Argentine side, with a walkway that descends past several overlooks to a catwalk over the falls, allowing guests to really get a sense of the power of the rushing water (prepare for a soaking if you choose to go all the way out). From the end of the main walkway, an elevator whisks guests back up to street level at the top of the cliff (there's also a trail up to the street for those who prefer not to wait in line for the lift).

Located on the same site that Bustillo Hotel and Cottages are accessible via the Avenue Pioneros, it has an incomparable view of Lake Nahuel Huapi. This family-friendly Bariloche hotel is located in a rural location in Bariloche. The Pioneers Hotel service includes a heated indoor pool.

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Excursion: Half Day Scenic Surroundings with chairlift – Shared
Date: 18th November

Leaving Bariloche to the west, the road winds gently along the shores of the Nahuel Huapi Lake with spectacular views of the Andean mountain range in the distance and the ever-changing colours of the lake in the foreground. As we drive along Bustillo Avenue to the right we come across Bonita Beach and the little Huemul Island. Further along the road Campanario Bay and Peak come into sight. The Chairlift here invites you to marvel at one of the most impressive views of lakes and imposing Andean Peaks. As you enjoy the view from this privileged panoramic point you can enjoy a coffee or have a snack.

The 360° panorama delivers beautiful views of the Nahuel Huapi and Perito Moreno lakes, the Clover lagoon, the San Pedro peninsula and the Llao Llao Hotel, Victoria Island and the peaks of the Otto, López, Goye and Cathedral Mountains as well as the spread of the city of Bariloche itself. Back on the road, the highlight after the San Pedro peninsula is charming Llao Llao Peninsula, heralded by the ancient San Eduardo chapel which stands on a hill overlooking the lake, as well as the small but nonetheless important port of Puerto Pañuelo, directly below the famous Llao Llao hotel. If you are lucky and the day is clear, Mt. Tronador might burst into sight with its snow-capped ridge holding the highest peak in the region. The road continues along the lakeshore, crossing the Angostura River which links the Moreno and Nahuel Huapi lakes coming to López Bay, at the foot of the mountain it homes. Here we approach another unique lookout spot. The drive then crosses the bridge over the Moreno Lake and along the Clover Lagoon to finally reach the Bustillo Avenue again towards Bariloche city.

Excursion: Full Day Perito Moreno Glacier – Shared
Date: 22nd November

Full-day tour to the Perito Moreno Glacier through the National Park, a beautiful drive of over an hour with stops to enjoy the view. At the Corner of Sighs a special stop gives guests their first impressive full view of the Glacier. During the drive, you might catch a glimpse of red and grey foxes, cinnamon-coloured guanaco deer balancing on rocky crags, or large Patagonian hares. Along the roadside crawl little armadillos, whose meat is highly prized by the local inhabitants, and if you are lucky you might just see the tawny back of a puma, a mountain lion. And, just possibly, way up above, you might spy the magnificent silhouette of the condor, apparently motionless, floating on the thermal wind currents that curl between the mountain peaks. The Perito Moreno Glacier is one of the world's largest reserves of fresh water, measuring 96.52 square miles - 250 square kilometres. It is one of the few glaciers that are advancing instead of retreating. It is thirty kms long, this imposing wall of ice towers some 70 metres above the walkways that offer you a selection of different views from the promontory of Península de Magallanes that juts out into the Lago Argentino. As you stand below gazing up at the massive rugged face, you become aware that the glacier is very much a living, evolving thing, that creaks and cracks with rifle like shots which preface the "desprendimientos", huge chunks the size of houses which break off and fall in slow motion through the air into the black waters. They hit the surface with an almighty crash, submerging and rising up again to bob away as icebergs into the centre of the lake. The biggest and most spectacular "desprendimientos" occur when the glacier has grown to form a bridge across to the promontory, thereby cutting off the water flow between Brazo Rico and

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the Canal de los Témpanos. The natural dam that forms supports increasing pressure which builds up as water and ice accumulate on the Brazo Rico side and the water soaks into the ice at the point at which the ice touches the land, slowly creating a tunnel. The tunnel becomes wider and wider until the pressure of the glacier moving forward fractures the bridge most dramatically. This dam/rupture cycle is not regular. Although local legend has it that this takes place every four years, it naturally recurs at any frequency between once a year to less than once a decade. The last time this event occurred was in 2012, when it brought photographers, film crews and glacier enthusiasts from all over the world to wait for weeks on end for that special moment.

Excursion: Safari Nautico
Date: 22nd November

The Nautical Safari is ideal to combine with a visit to the Perito Moreno catwalks. It departs from the Bajo de Las Sombras pier, 75 kilometres away from downtown El Calafate. Once all guests are on board, the excursion cruises the Brazo Rico, navigating beside icebergs which have calved off the south front of the Perito Moreno Glacier. Reaching the Icebergs Channel, the boat stops at a safe distance from the glacier and then sails along the entire face of the glacier allowing spectacular views of the impressive high ice walls. The excursion offers a different look at the Perito Moreno Glacier, with chunks of ice falling constantly into the water.
